 - More than 15 potential candidates were met last September;
 - Interviewing sessions will be held soon in 2020;
 - c) Chance to be selected candidates for construction job site:
 - The candidates with a trade qualification degree has direct access for the CCQ certification;
 - The candidates without a trade degree and having good skill will be accompanied in the process of obtaining and accessing the site by being trained with the ASP Construction Training company with a training session on health and safety on construction sites;
 - d) Hired on the project!

Training and development
